

## SMALL BORE COURSE OF FIRE AND RELAY CHANGES

RELAY 1 FIRES MATCH 1 STAGE 1 AT 50 YDS

RELAY 1 CHANGES TARGETS AND MOVES TARGET

STANDS TO THE 100YD LINE AND REPLACES TARGETS FOR STAGE 2

AFTER FIRING RELAY 1 REMOVES TARGETS AND MOVES THE STANDS TO THE 50 YD LINE.

RELAY 1 REMOVES EQUIPMENT FROM THE FIRING POINT IF THE POINT IS SHARED FOR THE NEXT RELAY.

RELAY 2 FIRES MATCH 1 STAGE 1 AT 50 YDS

RELAY 2 CHANGES TARGETS AND MOVES TARGET STANDS TO THE 100YD LINE AND REPLACES TARGETS

FOR STAGE 2-AFTER FIRING RELAY 2 REMOVES TARGETS AND LEAVES THE STANDS AT THE 100YD LINE

RELAY 1 FIRES MATCH 2 STAGE 1-REPLACES TARGETS AND FIRES STAGE 2

RELAY 2 FIRES MATCH 2 STAGE 1-REPLACES TARGETS AND FIRES STAGE 2-MOVES STANDS TO THE 50 YD LINE

RELAY 1 FIRES MATCH 3 STAGE 1-REPLACES TARGETS AND FIRES STAGE 2

RELAY 2 FIRES MATCH 3 STAGE 1-REPLACES TARGETS AND FIRES STAGE 2

Major difference for Small Bore matches, after firing is complete all rifles are GROUNDED WITH CHAMBER FLAGS IN PLACE, no handling rifles while anyone is forward of the firing line.

CHAMBER FLAGS MUST BE IN ALL RIFLES EXCEPT DURING PREP PERIOD AND LIVE FIRING

Rifles removed from the firing line during relay changes must be cased or in the rifle racks

SCORING: pass your target to the right, high end to low end, if close, plug.

CROSS FIRES: Don't take an extra shot, notify match official.

Cross Fire penalties: 1 point, extra shot on bull 1 point per shot
